

AUTO-CROSS RULES

Minnesota State Fairgrounds - St. Paul, MN

Friday, July 18th: 10 am - 5 pm | Saturday, July 19th: 9 am - 5 pm | Sunday, July 20th: 9 am - 1 pm

- 1. All Participants are required to sign and complete a) RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, b) MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER
- 2. Driver and passenger hands must remain in the vehicle at all times on the course.
- 3. No hand-held devices allowed for any reason (cameras, phones, etc).
- 4. **No restraints = No autocross** (Stock Seatbelts or approved harnesses are allowed).
- 5. All cars must have a properly functioning factory battery tie-down or a metal-only replacement
- 6. The vehicle must be mechanically sound and safe to withstand the loads of an autocross run at all times. No Nitrous in any class. There will be 2 tech times offered for drivers to get registered and tech inspected for their auto-cross time slot!

Tech Inspection times are:

- Friday, July 18th: 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.
- Saturday, July 29th: 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.
- Sunday, July 20th: 9 a.m. to 10 a.m.

IF YOUR CAR IS NOT TECHED, YOU WILL NOT RUN. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

- 7. Participants must follow the directions of any worker at all times without question.
- 8. Participants who drive unsafely or exhibit unsafe behavior during any segment of the event will be immediately disqualified and removed from the event.
- 9. **Tire Rules** All Participants must use commercially available, DOT-approved tires with a treadwear of 180 or higher. Hand-grooved tires or shaved treads are not allowed. Tires must have a minimum of 2/32" tread depth at the start of the event and must not show excessive wear or abuse. The use of any type of chemical or non-chemical treatment is strictly prohibited.
- 10. Once you have crossed the finish line, you must slow down to under 10 MPH. One warning will be given for excessive speed after the finish line. If you continue to speed past the finish line, you will be asked to leave. Stop pylons will be designated at a generous distance beyond the finish line.
- 11. Any vehicle that spins, loops, or leaves the autocross surface (2 or more wheels off) for any reason will be black-flagged.
- 12. **Helmets are required** for all Drivers and any passengers during the Autocross. Snell SA or M-rated helmets in good condition, dated 2005 or later. DOT-rated helmets are not allowed unless they are also Snell-rated. A full-face helmet is required if you do not have airbags and are not running a minimum of a 4-point restraint.
- 13. No items may be loose in the truck or cab area of the car during a run.
